The regular school board meeting for February was held at 7:00 p.m. on February 20. All board members were present.

Four CHS student/athletes were recognized for their selection to the all state football team. The Consent Agenda was approved, 7-0.

A Public Hearing for the 2006-2007 school calendar was held. Toby Howard presented this information.

Sam Bettes, Donna Walker and Michael Ramsay shared a PowerPoint presentation about the new A2E2 course at CHS.

District and Campus Improvement Plans were presented by Toby Howard, Michael Ramsay and Doug Wicks. These were approved, 7-0.

Board of trustees election clerks and election date of May 13 were approved, 7-0.

Board of trustees training requirements were reviewed.

A request from the Delta County Municipal Utilities District to share voting locations with the school district for May 13 was approved, 7-0.

TASB Policy Update 77 was approved on second reading, 7-0.

Budget Amendment #6 was approved, 7-0. This set in funds from Safe and Drug Free Schools, substitute teachers from Region VIII science workshops, student vandalism remuneration and Title VI funds.

Resignations from Dianne Thomas, Chasity Lenahan and Toby Howard, effective at the end of the school year, were accepted, 7-0.

Holly Wills was employed as a high school special education teacher, 7-0.

Contracts for elementary and high school principals were extended one year, 7-0.
