Regular School Board Meeting Summary**

**The regular school board meeting for April was held at 7:00 p.m. on April 17. All board members were present.**

**Jan Lewis' FCCLA students were recognized for their community service efforts. The Consent Agenda was approved, 7-0.**

**Chad Barnes and Chad Hohenberger were certified as unopposed candidates for school board on a 6-0 vote, with Chad Hohenberger abstaining.**

**A resolution to cancel the May 13 school board election was approved 6-0, with Chad Hohenberger abstaining.**

**Cooper Elementary P.T.O. presented a \$10,000 check to the district. These funds were raised by P.T.O. events and intended to go toward the construction of an awning on the south side of the elementary campus. This gift was approved, 7-0.**

**CHS Band Director Roderick Boyce presented information about a possible band trip for the 2006-07 school year.**

**The Head Start National Reporting System Outcomes Report was approved, 7-0.**

**A tax resale deed was approved, 7-0.**

**Student transfer information for 2006-07 was presented.**

**A multihazard emergency operations plan was presented.**

**Budget Amendment #8 was approved, 7-0. This sets in funds for substitute teacher reimbursement from Region 8 as well as funds from Title I and Title II.**

**Projected budget and staffing data was presented.**

**Resignations from Janie Pickett and Holly wills were accepted, 7-0.**

**Denicia Hohenberger was approved as Curriculum Director, 6-0 with Chad Hohenberger abstaining.**

**Superintendent Performance Goals were approved, 7-0.**
