The regular school board meeting for May was held at 7:00 p.m. on May 15. All board members were present. Justice of the Peace Larry Vandiver administered the oath of office to newly elected school board members Chad Barnes and Chad Hohenberger. Thomas Darden was re-elected as board president. Chad Hohenberger was elected vice-president and Allen Beeler was re-elected as secretary.

CHS Band Trip for next school year was approved, 7-0.
A Head Start One Time Supplement Grant was approved, 7-0.

A multihazard emergency operations plan was approved, 7-0..
Summer school plans were approved as presented, 7-0.

A request to purchase new computers was discussed.
A request to purchase security cameras for the high school parking lot was discussed.

Student insurance policy renewal with Texas Monarch Corporation for next school year was discussed.

Budget Amendment #9 was approved, 7-0. It moves E-rate funds for switches, adds in kind community service, adds PTO donations for elementary campus and adds additional athletic receipts.
